Tips

- Establish clear expectations and requirements
- Make learning materials available gradually
- Organize course content into units or modules

Three-Way Communication

Goal: Model effective communication by providing thorough information on class expectations and feedback

- Announcements
- Individual and group emails
- Feedback on assignments





- Ensure students know how to turn on LMS notifications
- Refer to students by name
- Establish routines for consistent communication

Assessment & Data Tracking

Goal: Utilize diverse forms of assessments to analyze students' academic growth

- Homework, quizzes, exit tickets, and projects
- Assignment management for tracking student progress
- Gradebook capabilities





Tips

- Develop assessments that can be automatically graded
- Utilize rubric features for feedback
- Utilize the LMS grading feature to provide feedback
