Collaboration Strategies

Individual **Accountability**



- Promote individual accountability by incorporating individual, partner, and whole-group tasks
- Use diverse ways for independent brainstorming and allow students to connect with peer ideas
- Assign roles to students
- Use surveys to promote student reflection on individual and team contributions

Team Norms & Expectations



- Ensure teams understand the goals and expectations of the activity
- Discuss healthy teamwork strategies that promote productivity
- Focus on how teams will reach agreement
- Convey how individual students and teams will be supported



Are students prepared to work collaboratively and efficiently?

Productivity




- Demonstrate how teams can develop SMART (specific, measurable, achievable, realistic, and timely) goals for more efficiency
- Assign roles or allow students to split responsibilities to support productivity
- Intentionally plan synchronous work time to support collaborative thinking



Are students sharing responsibilities to support productivity?

Communication



- Provide strategies to ensure communication is accessible and professional
- Demonstrate conflict resolution strategies teams can use when diverse perspectives are shared
- Identify options for efficient communication and collaboration (email, shared documents, etc.)
