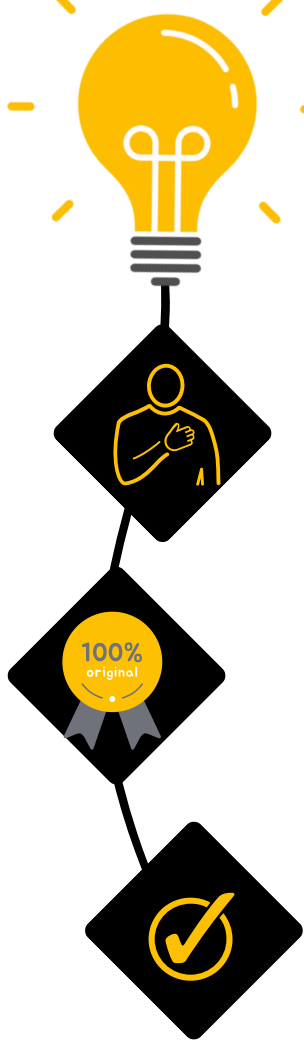


# ASSESSMENT AND MEASUREMENT

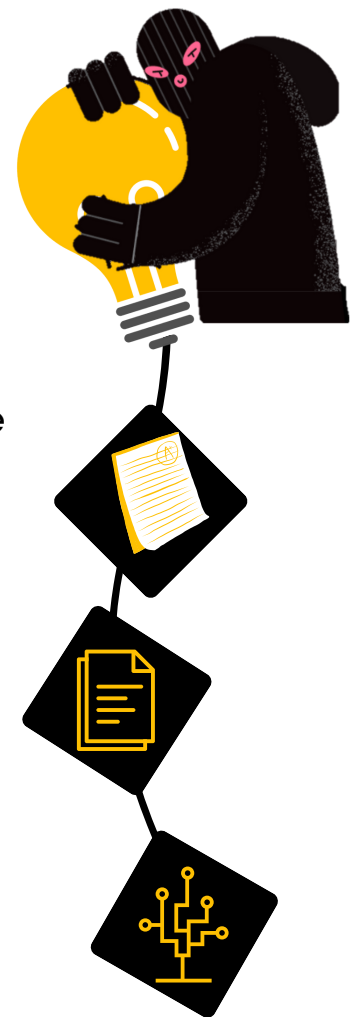
### DO'S

- 5 Demonstrate your **own achievement**
- 6 Do **original work**

### DON'TS

- 1 Don't copy or allow another student to **copy** your **answers** on assignments
- 2 Don't copy ideas, data, or wording **without citing** your electronic source
- 3 Don't **reuse** and submit your **past work** as new work without citing yourself
- 4 Don't have **others** complete your work for you
- 5 Don't use **electronic devices** and other **materials** without permission during exams
- 6 Don't take an exam for **another student**
