Recognizing Child Abuse and Neglect in Online Environments

PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT

When connecting with students who are learning in online environments, pay special attention to how they describe their physical environment. Be aware of physical environments for signs of abuse and neglect. Utilize LIVE video conferencing sessions to **observe any irregularities** in physical environments. STUDENT-TEACHER RELATIONSHIP

Be on the look-out for student behavior changes, and changes in the student-teacher relationship. Common red flags are **aggressiveness**, **short-temperedness**, and **lack of respect**.

90%

of child victims are abused by individuals they **know, love,** and **trust**



ESTABLISHED ROUTINES



Monitor carefully if any students deviate from the established weekly routine. **Document** absences, frequent distractions from class activities, disruptive environments, and injuries to **identify** any **trends** to **abnormal student behavior**.

CHANGES IN STUDENT'S SCHOOL CONNECTIONS



Remember that students communicate with various school personnel. Be aware of other school-related **connections** and **interactions** with them for **negative changes**.



STUDENT-FAMILY INTERACTION

Schools may organize events where students' family members are invited. Be aware of how students **interact** with their **parents** or **family members**.



PROTOCOLS AND SELF-REPORTING

Students should have a safe and easy way to share their concerns in online learning environments (which could be neglect and abuse). Consider using a "safe" word or sign for students to communicate sensitive needs.
