Teachers can


Create a sense of community

Engagement



- their videos and toggle the gallery view to see their class
- •••Use breakout rooms to allow students to work together in small groups

Reaction



- Have students use the "raise hands" button to ask a question or respond to your questions
- reactions to clap or give a thumbs up

Reflection



- Pause often to allow time for students to reflect on learning and ask questions
- Have students use reactions to clap or give a thumbs up
